CORK OAK
"Quercus Fagaceae"

With a very thick bark, which is manually stripped for commercial cork, this specie is mostly known in Portugal as "sobreiro". This country accounts for 50% of the world cork harvest.

The Cork Oak lives about 150-250 years, and can be harvested a dozen times in its lifetime.

The Cork Oak is a Mediterranean evergreen tree, also called cork tree. Oak trees are any tree or shrub of the genus Quercus of the family Fagaceae.

Eucalyptus is a tree native to Australia. It was planted all around the world, in places such as North and South Africa, India and Southern Europe.

It has aromatic leaves that yield an oil used medicinally and its wood is valued as timber. Its softwood is used to make paper.

It is a quick grower and many species reach a great height, being one of the tallest trees in the world!
